




3D MARINE AIRCRAFT WING COMMANDING GENERAL'S GUIDANCE



MOTORCYCLE SIMULATORS

Our combat readiness and unit cohesion are affected when Marines or Sailors are lost or injured due to accidents. It is imperative that safe practices, both on and off duty are maintained. Motorcycle mishaps make up over 41 percent of our motor vehicle mishaps suffered within our Wing. Basic motorcycle knowledge, skills development training, and proper risk management have been instituted with the aide of motorcycle simulators in order to enhance motorcycle safety.

Motorcycle Simulators are computer-based interactive systems designed to replicate real world motorcycle riding and hazardous conditions. These resources improve rider skills and provide our motorcyclists with skills that foster safe riding techniques.

Our motorcycle riders shall complete motorcycle simulator training prior to attending the installation's Basic Rider's Course. This training will be conducted in accordance with the simulator training requirements in the enclosure of the 3d MAW Motorcycle Safety Order (Wing Order 5100.10A).

Marines and Sailors at all levels are reminded that failure to attend training is not tolerated. Appropriate administrative or disciplinary action shall be taken for violators. (MCO 5100.19F)

I need each and every warrior in 3d MAW to be healthy, highly trained, and ready to achieve operational excellence. Leadership and training are keys to preventing mishaps and injuries affecting unit readiness. We will continue to add to 3d MAW's outstanding legacy through our commitment to Operational Excellence.
