



## **MARINE AIRCRAFT GROUP 11 COMMANDING OFFICER'S GUIDANCE**



### **COMMANDER'S SIGNIFICANT NOTIFICATION EVENTS**

#### **IMMEDIATE CALL FROM SQUADRON CO TO MAG CO**

- Any loss of life or serious injury of a MAG-11 Marine, Sailor, or dependent.
- Any loss of a MAG-11 aircraft or critical mission asset.
- Any other incident meeting Class A, B, or C mishap criteria.
- Any unexplained overdue aircraft.
- Any compromise/loss of classified material, information, or EKMS equipment.
- Any missing or lost weapon or controlled ordnance item.
- Any significant event which may call into question the professionalism of or result in negative media attention towards MAG-11 or MAG-11 units.
- Any non-routine personal or operational General or Flag Officer communication.

#### **NOTIFY AS SOON AS POSSIBLE VIA EMAIL**

- Any incident or event which necessitates the release of an OPREP-3.
- Any arrest of a MAG-11 Marine or Sailor by civilian authorities.

#### **EMAIL (NIPR/SIPR) WITH INFO/PLAN - FOLLOW UP PHONE CALL AS REQUIRED**

- Squadron COs will explain the necessity to fly sorties beyond PMCF's to the MAG CO prior to the first scheduled flight of the day when aircraft readiness is below 50% RBA.
- Any officer or SNCO misconduct.
- Any incident meeting Class D or lower mishap criteria.
- Incident Response Events (EOD bomb/UXO disposal response).
- Any aircraft divert due to an emergency.
- Any decrease in DRRS-MC rating.
- Any early return of squadron members from forward deployed units.
- Any unscheduled inspections/audits by activities external to MAG-11.
- Any significant event involving the dependent of a MAG-11 Marine or Sailor, to include arrest, hospital admittance, or removal of a child from the home by Child Protective Services.
