



MARINE AIRCRAFT GROUP 16 COMMANDER'S GUIDANCE



COMMANDER'S CRITICAL INFORMATION REQUIREMENTS (CCIRs)

- Any loss of life within MAG-16, to include Marines, Sailors, or hired Civilians.
- Any loss of MAG-16 aircraft or critical mission assets, to include class A/B/C aviation mishaps.
- Compromise of classified material, information, or EKMS equipment.
- Any event that requires notification to HQMC, MARFORPAC, I MEF, or 3rd MAW
- Any incident that is reportable by CMC or HQMC policies.
- Any General Officer or Flag Officer communication
- Any significant event that may call into question the professionalism of MAG-16.
- Any threat to the assets, resources, or Marines, Sailors, and Families of MAG-16.
- Denial of support or dropped FRAG.
- In all cases: when in doubt, call or notify. I am available day or night.
