

Marine Aircraft Group 16 Commander's Critical Information Requirements (CCIRs)



- 1. Any loss of life within MAG-16, to include Marines, Sailors, hired civilians, and immediate family members.
- 2. Any loss of MAG-16 aircraft or critical mission assets, to include class A/B/C aviation mishaps.
- 3. Any compromise of classified material, information, or EKMS equipment.
- 4. Any event that requires notification to 3d MAW, I MEF, MARFORPAC, or HQMC.
- 5. Any incident that is reportable by CMC or HQMC policies.
- 6. Any incident of large scale civil disorder involving MAG-16 units or personnel.
- 7. Any acts of nature (destructive weather conditions, fires, earthquakes, ect.) that pose a serious threat to life or property.
- 8. Any event of a military or political nature, foreign or domestic, that involves MAG-16 units or personnel that may result in local or national official reaction, U.S. Congressional interest, or media attention.
- 9. Any significant event that may call into question the professionalism of MAG-16.
- 10. Any bomb threat, active shooter, or any other event or incident of actual or suspected cover action against MAG 16 units or personnel.
- 11. Any threat to the assets, resources, or Marines, Sailors, and families of MAG-16.
- 12. Any denial of support or dropped FRAG.

Generally, all of the topics listed above would require a decision maker to make a decision. Do not feel limited by the items above. I am available day or night and ready to discuss any issue you feel I should know about. Do NOT hesitate to contact me or any other member of the command team if you feel that there is something that needs to be brought to our attention in order to aide us in making a more informed decision.
