NCIS **TIPS**

1. Download **NCIS Tips** from your mobile provider's marketplace.
2. Select Submit New Tip.
3. Select Type of Crime.
4. Complete the form with as much information as possible.
5. Choose to attach a photo or video.
6. Select Submit.
7. Enable push notifications in phone settings to receive alerts.

Privacy

Our web and mobile app was designed to keep communities safe without violating your confidentiality. NCIS Tips does not track your location or other information. All tip submissions are safe, discreet, and anonymous.



Connectivity

Stay **connected** with NCIS.

When you submit a tip, you can choose to receive push notifications on your smart device to stay connected with NCIS.



Rewards

NCIS offers **rewards**.

NCIS may provide a reward to you for information that leads to a felony conviction.

Frequently Asked Questions

What types of crimes should I report?

You should report criminal activities, including homicide, rape, sexual assault, child physical and sexual abuse, burglary and robbery, larceny of government and personal property, and aggravated assault. You should also report suspected terrorist, force protection, and insider threats.

How do I submit a tip using NCIS Tips?

To submit an anonymous tip, you can download the NCIS Tips application on your smart device, as shown on the back of this brochure. You can also visit www.ncis.navy.mil to submit a web-based tip.

What happens when I submit a tip using NCIS Tips?

When you submit a tip using NCIS Tips, you will receive a unique tip number and be able to communicate directly with an NCIS representative. Your identity will remain anonymous unless you provide it to NCIS.

How do I report additional information?

You can provide additional information to supplement your original tip by logging onto NCIS Tips using your tip number. If you lose your tip number, just submit a new tip.

Can I still call or go directly to my local NCIS field office to report a tip?
