I classify our family resiliency and readiness as a Mission Essential Task, equally important as individual and equipment readiness. With well-informed and well-supported families, our squadron will be better prepared in all facets to respond to whatever the future may hold.

As a Marine, Sailor, or family member of VMFA-122 you are entitled to certain military programs and services and I am dedicated to providing you and your families with the resources, education, and referrals needed for these programs.
