Suicide Prevention: Mental and physical health is one of my top priorities. Suicide prevention begins with intrusive leadership and genuine care for the members of our team all day, every day. Our most important asset is not the aircraft, but the Marine or Sailor who bare the patch of the Evil Eyes. We must be proactive in recognizing any symptoms and intervening in a moments notice. Trust your instinct, take the initiative, ask the tough questions and take action when it is needed the most. Ensure you keep a balanced lifestyle, know when to ask for help and openly communicate your needs. We will always be a squadron who makes the person first!

Alcohol and Substance Abuse: As a family we must fundamentally take care of each other. All too often alcohol is a common denominator for disciplinary problems, criminal acts, and violations of the UCMJ. Moreover, many lose sight of the fact that Illegal drug use is a crime and will not be tolerated. We must dedicate ourselves to preventing alcohol and substance abuse, proactively seeking support for yourselves and others, before it impacts mission effectiveness. A deliberate abuse of alcohol and substances will not be tolerated and dealt with accordingly.

Equal Opportunity: Each member of this organization can expect to be valued – with dignity and respect – regardless of race, religion, gender, age, sexual orientation or national origin. Violence Prevention and Prohibitive Activities and Conduct: We are men and women of character, united in our efforts to prevent any behavior that is cruel, abusive, humiliating, oppressive, demeaning, or harmful. Any instance of harassment, hazing, bullying, ostracism, retaliation, distribution of intimate images and/or supremacist activity is prohibited and will not be tolerated.

Sexual Assault: Trust and compassion are foundational to what makes us the Evil Eyes family. Sexual assault is not only a crime, but a profound violation of trust, and will not be tolerated. We are all responsible – morally and ethically – to take decisive action to prevent any situation that could lead to sexual assault. Victims of sexual assault shall be cared for with compassion, dignity, and respect. Uniformed Victim Advocates and chaplain support will be available 24/7.

Family Readiness: Family is the heart and soul of VMM-163 and foundational to the Evil Eye's culture and our continued success. It is essential that we – the Command Team, the URC, DRC, and every Marine and Sailor – encourage authentic leadership, open communication, and genuine care for our families.
